California Confection is a delightful little girl's dress or woman's nightgown created from swiss lawn and swiss voile, with floche used for the embroidery. They have delectable design choices including petite pintucks, ambrosial applique, exquisite embroidery, scrumptious sleeves, and confectionary collars! In addition to the what/where/why of the elements of the garment construction, we will talk about design options— hand techniques vs. machine techniques, adding or deleting a design element and how that will affect the structure/construction of the garment.

Hand Techniques: french knot, bullion, pin stitch, madeira applique, pintucks using 4 different hand techniques.

Machine Techniques : Pintucks, Construction

Pattern for Yoke Dress 2-6 or Women's nightgown (calf length-extra length available for add'l fee), 4 combinations of white, light blue or pale pink swiss lawn, floche, YLI thread, hand needles, swedish tracing paper, piping cord, class notes

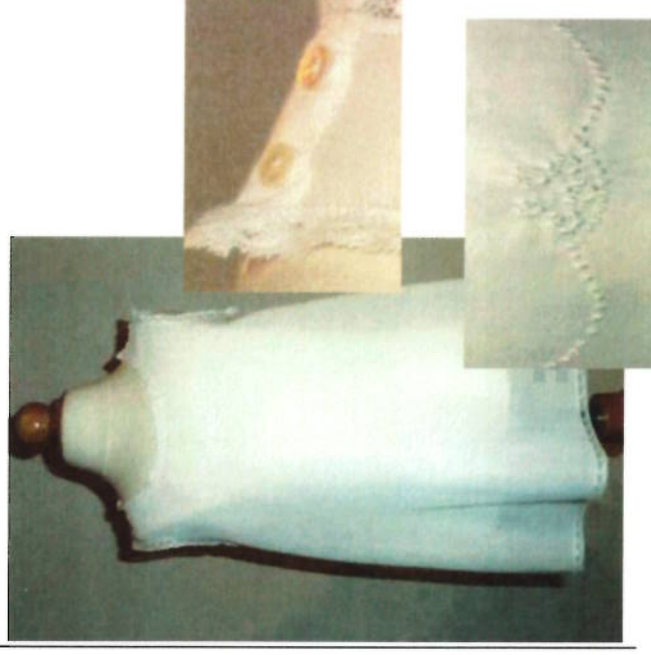

Just as important, although it may not be seen, is a slip! The slip can change the look of a dress - bring out fullness, provide a base for sheer fabrics, and give body to a dress. In *Simply Slips* learn how to alter a dress pattern to make your own slips as well as make a simple A-line slip. You will choose how to make it your own as options are endless - lace around the hem, button on the shoulder, embroidery on the bodice or at the hemline. A slip is an extension of the dress and *Simply Slips* will give you the foundation you need to create the look you want.

Kit Contents: 100% cotton swiss lawn, 100% cotton french lace edging, floche, mother of pearl buttons, thread, needles, embroidery design, class notes, pattern for 2 styles of slips

Techniques: Creating your pattern style, eyelet, granito, point de paris (pin stitch), construction tips
